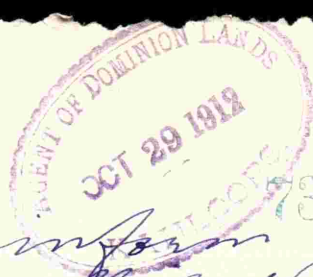



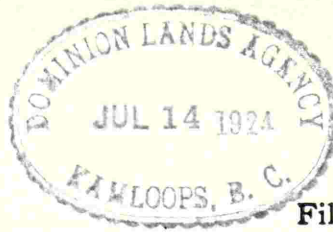

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of the application of James Alexander Good, Esq., for patent to his homestead, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 29, Range 22, W 5th Meridian, and in connection therewith note this homesteader claims to have put in three months' residence each year since 1918, with the exception that in 1921 he resided on the homestead for four months. The Regulations require that continuous six months' residence in each year must be performed, although this does not of necessity mean the Calendar Year. For instance, residence from the first of October, 1918, to the 31st of March, 1919, would be continuous six months. The Department have heretofore refused applications for patent when it is not shown that the residence has been continuous for the required period or the six months' residence has been performed within twelve consecutive months.

Under these circumstances, it would not be advisable for me to submit this application for patent in its present form, and I am returning it in order that you may secure definite dates as to the period of residence. You will note that Question 4 requires that actual dates be given.

Many thanks for your kind letter of above date. Mrs Lumsden has power of Attorney for me & if opportunity presents may accept your offer. I have told her that you will give her advice as to how to proceed & please accept my best thanks in anticipation. We are still here trying to do our bit, but the feeling seems to be general that the war will not last many more months. We trust not to have another year of it, the cost in human

life is too enormous, but it is much more so to the enemy.

Have not met Mr. E. Trimble, although I have heard about him, & where he is.

We have very good quarters & a good bunch of officers, our food is good, & we are working 10 hours a day, & just as hard as for a commercial firm. The whole thing is run like a commercial business & has upset our previous ideas of what to expect in the Army.
