



I beg to inform you that a period of 30 days from this date is hereby given you in which to appear at this office and make application for entry for the N.E. Sec. 22 Tp. 29 Rg. 23, West 5th Meridian, providing you are eligible, on payment of the required fee, (\$10).

If you so desire, you may make application before a Sub-agent for this district, but such application, or the telegraphic advice of such application from the Sub-agent, must be received in this office before the expiration of the 30 days period above mentioned.

In the event of uncertainty as to the correctness of your valuation, or if the value of the improvements is placed at over \$25, the Agent shall cause such improvements to be examined and valued by a Homestead Inspector. If a surplus has been paid, the excess amount may be refunded. If insufficient has been paid, you must at once pay the difference, otherwise your entry may be cancelled.

Should you fail to secure entry within the thirty days allowed, your prior right of entry will lapse and the land will be otherwise disposed of.


